## 02 Physical & Cyber Mitigation

### BASELINE OPERATIONAL POSTURE: MODERATE

- Conduct pre-event security briefing with all staff and vendors.
- Establish a unified incident command structure with clear chain of command.
- Implement event-specific credential system with color-coded access tiers.
- Deploy walk-through magnetometers at all primary access points.
- Implement 100% bag inspection at venue entry.
- Station uniformed and plainclothes security at 1:100 attendee ratio.

### IED / EXPLOSIVE DEVICE THREAT PROTOCOL

#### PHYSICAL SECURITY PROTOCOLS

- Conduct minimum two magnetometer sweeps of venue interior 90 and 30 minutes pre-open.
- Deploy K9 explosive detection unit for interior venue sweep; certify handler and canine.
- Implement 100% bag and credential screening at all access points; no exceptions.
- Establish a vehicle exclusion zone of no less than 100 feet from primary structure.
- Brief all staff on suspicious package indicators and IED recognition.
- Designate venue bomb threat protocol including evacuation rally points and sweep team.
- Coordinate with local bomb disposal unit (EOD) and establish direct contact number.

#### COMMUNICATIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Establish pre-event direct contact with local PD EOD unit and bomb threat hotline.
- Brief venue staff on coded language for IED alerts to avoid public panic.

### MASS CASUALTY EVENT (MCE) MEDICAL PROTOCOL

#### PHYSICAL SECURITY PROTOCOLS

- Station minimum one licensed EMT per 250 attendees; ALS unit for 1,000+ events.
- Identify and pre-clear a helicopter landing zone (HLZ) within 500 meters of venue.
- Pre-position AED units every 200 feet of primary attendee area; mark with high-visibility signage.
- Establish a casualty collection point (CCP) away from primary access/egress routes.
- Coordinate mutual aid agreement with nearest Level 1 Trauma Center.
- Pre-assign triage sectors and designate walking wounded versus litter patient routes.
- Brief all event medical staff on mass casualty incident (MCI) triage protocols (START/SALT).

## COMMUNICATIONS REQUIREMENTS

Establish pre-event radio channel shared between medical team and venue security.

Provide medical team lead with direct contact numbers for all three nearest hospitals.

Coordinate direct dispatch line to local EMS dispatch center.

**ACTIVE AGGRESSOR RESPONSE PROTOCOL**

## PHYSICAL SECURITY PROTOCOLS

Deploy plainclothes security personnel at all primary access points and crowd density zones.

Establish a Unified Command Post (UCP) within 500 feet of the venue perimeter.

Pre-position armed quick reaction force (QRF) at two concealed staging locations.

Conduct 360-degree venue sweep no less than 90 minutes prior to event open.

Station uniformed and plainclothes personnel at all vendor corridors and service entrances.

Brief all event staff on run-hide-fight protocol and emergency code words.

Coordinate direct radio channel with local law enforcement dispatch.

## COMMUNICATIONS REQUIREMENTS

Establish dedicated radio channel between security lead and local PD watch commander.

Pre-distribute emergency lockdown codes to all venue operations staff.

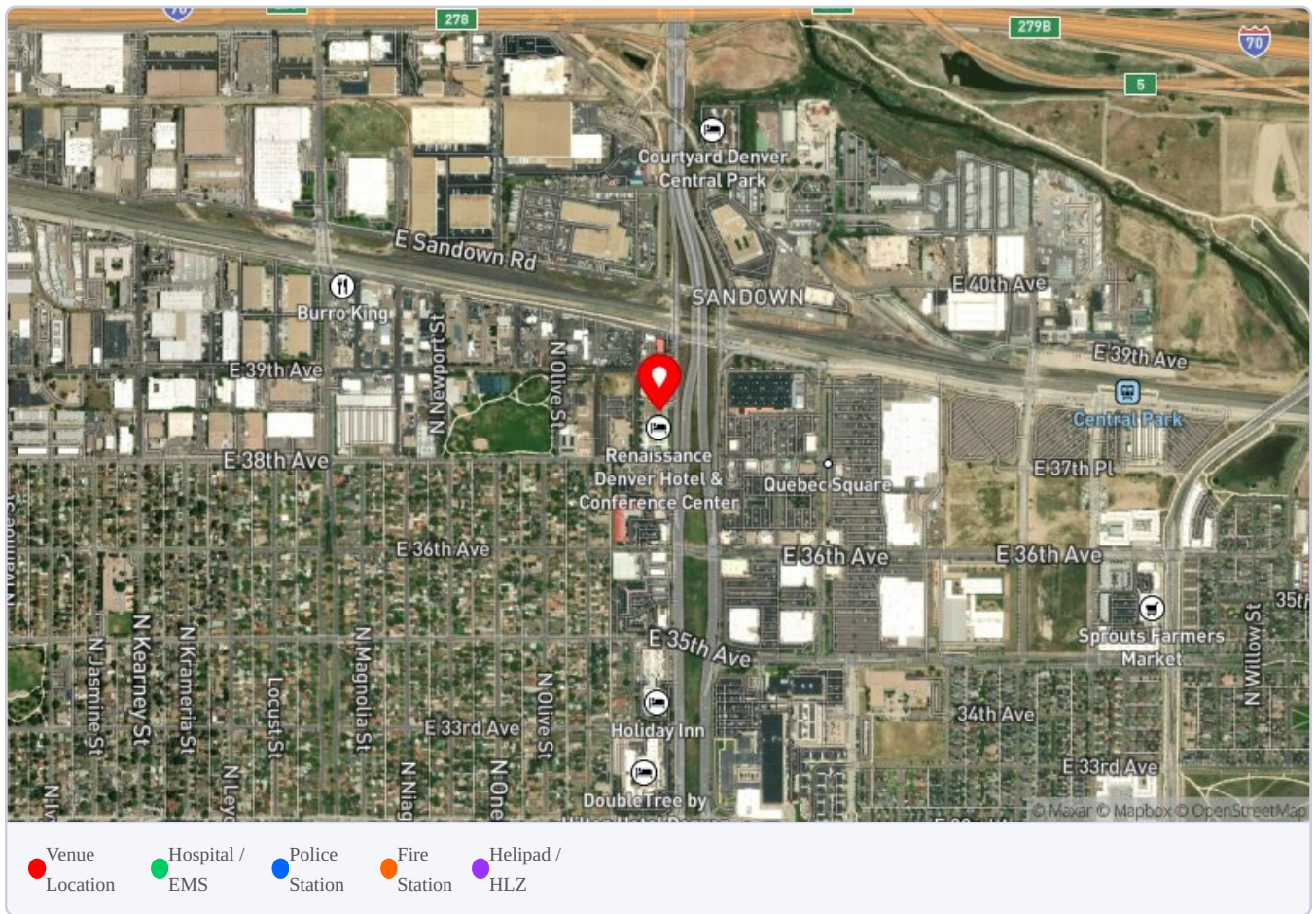

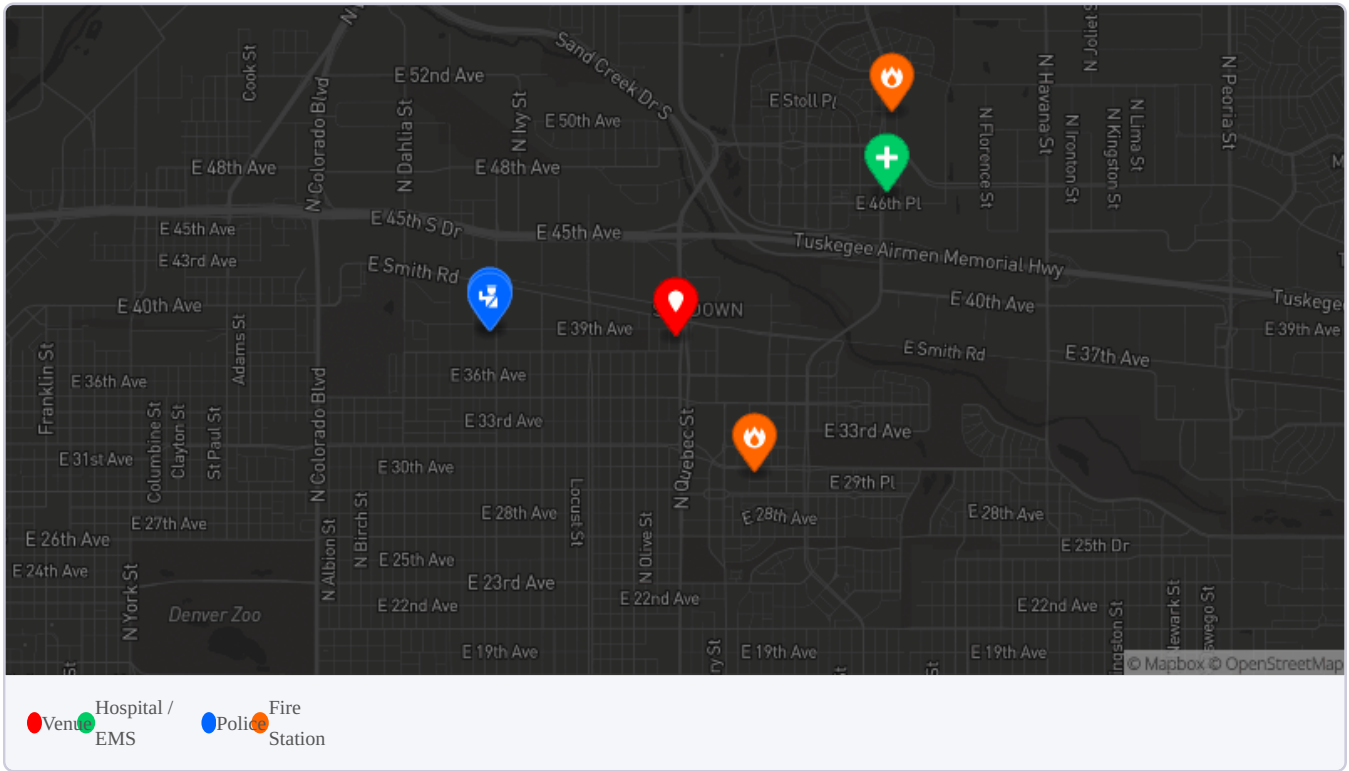

### PRIMARY EGRESS CORRIDORS – CARDINAL DIRECTIONS

Direction	Egress Corridor	Priority Use	Notes
↑ NORTH	Northern road network egress	Primary vehicle evacuation	Verify routes with venue advance survey
→ EAST	Eastern road network egress	Secondary vehicle / pedestrian	Activate if northern corridor is compromised
↓ SOUTH	Southern road network egress	Secondary vehicle evacuation	Confirm access with venue operations
← WEST	Western road network egress	Tertiary / VIP exfil route	Pre-clear for principal vehicle movement

Egress corridors are based on cardinal road network access from venue coordinates. Security lead must conduct a physical advance survey to confirm all routes prior to event day. Prioritize routes away from any active incident quadrant.

Primary Egress	Main access points — all 7 points	P1	Normal flow unless compromised at incident site
Secondary Egress	Service/vendor entrances — pre-clear with venue ops	P2	Activate if primary access is within threat zone

VIP Exfil	Dedicated principal route — pre-cleared, driver staged	P1-A	Required for 2 principal(s)
Rally Point Alpha	Designated outdoor assembly area — minimum 200m from structure	P1 default	Brief all staff on location pre-event
Rally Point Bravo	Secondary assembly — alternate direction from venue	P2 alternate	Activate if Alpha is within incident perimeter

**Evacuation Planning Notes:** All evacuation routes must be physically walked by security lead no less than 2 hours prior to event open. Confirm all fire exits are unlocked and unobstructed. Identify nearest cross streets for EMS guidance. Post event staff with radio at each rally point during evacuation.

# 05 Communications Plan

RADIO · EMERGENCY FREQUENCIES · ESCALATION PROTOCOL · CRISIS COMMS

**EMERGENCY** **Universal Emergency:** 911 — all staff to have local dispatch direct line as secondary  
Pre-obtain direct non-emergency line for local police precinct and have it posted at all security stations.

**RADIO** **Event Security Radio Net:** Dedicated UHF/VHF channel — assign pre-event  
All security, medical, and operations staff on same primary channel. Establish encrypted backup channel for incident command only.

**FIRE/EMS** **Local Fire / EMS Direct:** Obtain dispatch direct line from local fire authority prior to event  
Do not rely on 911 for mass casualty events — direct EMS dispatch contact reduces response time.

**CODE WORDS** **Incident Code Words (assign pre-event):**

<b>CODE RED</b>	Active threat / aggressor — immediate lockdown
<b>CODE AMBER</b>	Suspicious person / item — investigate, do not alert public
<b>CODE GREEN</b>	All clear — resume normal operations
<b>CODE BLUE</b>	Medical emergency — summon EMS to location
<b>EVACUATION</b>	Immediate full evacuation — all staff to designated roles

**ESCALATION** **Incident Escalation Chain:**

1. On-site Security Lead — immediate notification
2. Event Director / Client Point of Contact
3. Local Law Enforcement (if not already on site)
4. Venue Operations Manager
5. Legal / PR Contact (for media-visible incidents)

**BACKUP** **Communications Fallback:** In case of network/radio failure

- Establish designated runner protocol between key posts
- Pre-position physical site maps at each security station
- Confirm cellular coverage at venue prior to event day
- Identify cellular dead zones and plan hardwired phone backup

**MEDIA** **Media / Public Communication Protocol:**

Designate a single authorized spokesperson. Security incidents should not be commented on in real-time. Pre-draft holding statements for: (1) medical emergency, (2) evacuation, (3) active threat. All media inquiries to designated PR contact only.
